A CASUAL STORY

This is not just a story of a boat, but of the various lives that were impacted as it passed from one owner to another.

I first met Ron Van Horn at an old boat show in 1985. A group of 17 wood boat lovers were planning to petition ACBS to form a local chapter, "The Prairie State Boaters" Chapter, later changed to the "Blackhawk" Chapter. It was accepted by ACBS on 22nd Feb 1986. As most of you know Captain Ron was a colorful

It's powered by twin 105HP Model KL engines, has seating for at least 12, and a V berth. Ron bought the boat from Rodi Marine in Chicago. At Rodi it was up on the 5th or 6th floor of a building next to the Chicago River. After the deal was struck, it was slid out of a door on that upper floor and lowered down directly into the water from a beam extending over the river. The name came from an old Chris Craft advertisement that stated something like "imagine sitting in your Semi-Enclosed Cruiser in casual elegance".

It was always a pleasure to ride along with him in any weather, knowing he had enough bilge pump capacity to keep it afloat. The original Chris Craft ice locker was often stocked with Captain Morgan, Korbel Brut, and a case or two of beer. Cindy & I were so impressed with the features of Casual we wished we had a boat like her. So when one was found at Gage Marine, we bought it, but that's another story.



As time went on, Ron decided it was time to pass Casual on, but wanted someone who would love and respect the vessel as he did. He found that person in his friend Barry Hynes, also a Captain with a 100 Ton Masters License. Barry and his first mate Vanessa had a 1958 Chris Craft 15' Cavalier. He thought they needed something else like a vintage car to round out their stable. One day he came home announcing to Vanessa he has just bought a great addition, but instead of a car, it was "Casual Elegance", although it needed just a bit of work. Barry went on to make improvements, 12 volt conversion, new throttle cables, some bottom work, rebuilt the trailer. and many others.

Sadly both Ron and Barry have gone, leaving Vanessa to find the next caretaker. There were a few people interested, but not the type who would do the boat justice. One fellow said if he bought the boat he would scrap it and sell off the parts. Finally the folks at Hands On Deck, a 501c3 in Green Bay, heard of Casual and were anxious to acquire it. They thought it would fit in nicely with their goal of educating people of all ages, especially youth, the basics of wood working and STEM, through their boat building and restoration programs. Casual is now properly stored in Green Bay at their facility waiting for the work to begin. I think Ron and Barry are up there somewhere smiling.






