## ACBS BLACKHAWK CHAPTER 2016 Geneva Lakes Boat Show Lake Cruise, Estate Tour and Welcome Dinner

The 2016 Geneva Lakes Antique & Classic Boat Show was held at the Abbey Resort and Abbey Marina September 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>. The event was a showcase for over 90 boats in the water and over 50 boats on land. The weekend started off early Friday morning with the Estate Tour. Over 200 members and guest enjoyed a beautiful morning to see some of the most interesting properties on Geneva Lake. We visited three estates, traveled on classic lake launches and enjoyed a luncheon at the Lake Geneva Country Club.



This year the transportation to each property was special. In addition to the Gage boats we had the opportunity to ride on three wonderful boats from the collection of Larry and Sue Larkin. Sea Lark, Hathor and Normandie were all in service for our tour. Just a few years ago Larry completed the restoration of Hathor and earlier this summer Larry completed the re-commissioning of Normandie. It was a rare treat to see all three of these boats out on the lake!

Our first stop was at the summer home of Bob Kelly and Carolyn Smeltzer. This home is located on the Westgate Estate, a large property that takes its name from Charles Westgate, the husband of Gertrude Allen, who was heir to Central Leather Company fortune. The property has been subdivided twice over the years and now includes seven homes.

Mr. Kelly was the founder of National Investment Management specializing in institutional investment funds, now retired, and Dr. Smeltzer, a nurse who was Vice President of nursing at



University of Chicago Hospital and more recently a partner at Price Waterhouse Coopers. She has written a number of books depicting the history of homes and institutions around Lake Geneva, most recently a book about the early camps on the lake titled Camps of Geneva Lake.



The home was built in 2012 by Michael Keefe, a local realtor, and was remodeled when Bob and Carolyn purchased the home last year, renaming it Flower Cottage. The ten thousand-square foot home is surrounded by a cutting garden on the lake side, and three welcoming gardens on the other sides, as well as a rock garden. The owners enjoyed bringing the outside beauty of the gardens inside, every room having flowers worked into the decor. Cindy Wilson assisted the owners in decorating the home.

Carolyn met us at the door and conducted the tour and shared with us many of the unique aspects of their home.

Our next stop was at the home of Mark Licht, the former owner of Licht Paint Company which operated many paint stores in the western suburbs of Chicago. This home is located on the estate of John M. Smyth, founder of a high-end furniture company in 1890, and later, in the 1960's, created Homemakers. The home was originally constructed in 1970 by Karl Otzen and is based on a California Deck House design.





The home has recently undergone an extensive two-year renovation, and the interior, especially the office of Mr. Licht, is spectacular. We saw custom woodwork throughout, wonderful ceramic tile floors, specially designed light fixtures, and a 650 gallon salt water aquarium.

Our final stop was at the home of Ken and Sue Koranda. It is modeled after Fallingwater, the famous Frank Lloyd Wright designed home in southwestern Pennsylvania. It is an incredible home with interior design elements, furniture, carpets, lighting fixtures and accessories all custom made in the same Wright style. There are a number of waterfalls, both inside and out, that were in operation. The home is surrounded by natural landscaping, enhanced by Mr. Koranda who serves on the board of Morton Arboretum.





We wrapped up a wonderful estate tour with a luncheon at the Lake Geneva Country Club. The club sits on the south shore of Geneva Lake and the beautify manicured grounds and clubhouse are the perfect venue for our group to get together. We enjoyed a diverse buffet of sandwiches, salads and desserts. We would like to thank the club and their management for sharing their facilities with our event. The Friday Welcome Dinner was held at the estate of Dana and Patti Mecum. 300 members and guests attended this remarkable evening. Dana and Patti were extremely kind and generous to share their wonderful lake home with us. With over 33,000 square feet of space under roof, there was so much to see and enjoy! Not only did we have an opportunity to see their home but we also had the unique privilege to see some of Dana and Patti's private car collection.




