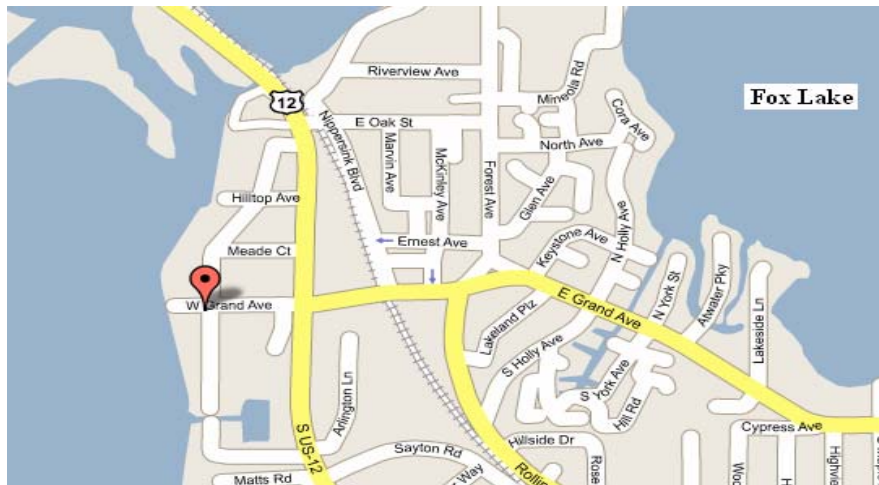

2006 Spring Dinner Meeting Dockers in Fox Lake

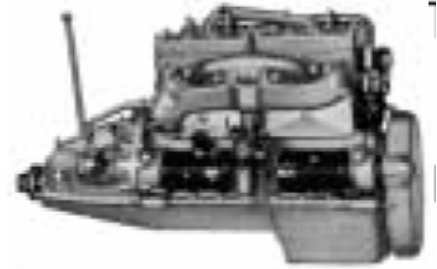
Sunday, April 23rd, 5:30 p.m.
